Reading

- Read ahead to help with fluency and expression.
- Comments on plot, setting and characters in familiar and unfamiliar stories.
- Recounts main themes and events.
- Comments on structure of the text.
- Use commas, question marks and exclamation marks to vary expression.
- Read aloud with expression & intonation.
- Recognise: “speech marks” contractions
- Identify past/present tense.
- Use content and index to locate information.

Writing

- Write different kinds of sentence: statement, question, exclamation, command.
- Use expanded noun phrases to add description and specification.
- Write using subordination (when, if, that, because). • Correct and consistent use of present tense and past tense.
- Correct use of verb tenses.
- Correct and consistent use of: capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks.
- Commas in a list.
- Apostrophe (omission e.g. don't).
- Introduction of speech marks (inverted commas)
- Evidence of diagonal and horizontal strokes to join handwriting.

Mathematics

- Compare and order numbers up to 100
- Read and write all numbers to 100 in digits and words.
- Say 10 more/less than any number to 100.
- Count in multiples of 2, 3, 5 & 10 from any number up to 100.
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 & 10 tables.
- Recall and use +/- facts to 20.
- Derive and use related facts to 100.
- Recognise Place Value of any 2-digit number.
- Add and subtract: 2-digit numbers and ones, 2-digit numbers and tens, Two 2-digit numbers, Three 1-digit numbers
- Recognise and use inverse (+/-).
- Calculate and write multiplication & division calculations using multiplication tables.
- Recognise and use inverse (\times/\div).
- Recognise, find, name & write $\frac{1}{3}$; $\frac{1}{4}$; $\frac{2}{4}$; $\frac{3}{4}$.
- Recognise equivalence of simple fractions.
- Tell time to five minutes, including quarter past/to.

Grammar

Grammar is a hot topic in Year 2! Children this age are expected to understand the following terms, to be able to spot them in their reading and apply them in their writing:

Noun, adjective, adverb, suffix, subordination, noun phrase, past tense, present tense, statement, question, exclamation, command, capital letter, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark, compound sentence and expanded noun phrase.
